

WaterSense Labeled Showerhead Replacement Program
Description, Terms, and Conditions

Purpose:

In an effort to further improve upon water conservation the District is conducting a cooperative funding initiative project with the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) that will offer commercial and residential water customer's free WaterSense labeled showerheads replacing existing high-volume showerheads.

A maximum of two (2) WaterSense labeled showerheads, per residential home and commercial establishment, will be provided depending on the number of showers at the residence or establishment. BLCCDD will provide two (2) options for showerheads to include a handheld showerhead and a direct mount showerhead.

According to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), Showering is one of the leading ways we use water in the home, accounting for nearly seventeen (17) percent of residential indoor water use. The average showerhead utilizes 2.5 GPM whereas showerheads designated with the WaterSense label are required to utilize 2.0 GPM or less. The Water-Sense label also ensures that these products provide a satisfactory shower that is equal to or better than conventional showerheads on the market. EPA worked with a variety of stakeholders, including consumers who tested various showerheads, to develop criteria for water coverage and spray intensity. All products bearing the WaterSense label, including water efficient showerheads, must be independently certified to ensure they meet EPA water efficiency and performance criteria.

Cost:

This program will provide up to two (2) pre-purchased WaterSense labeled Showerheads at no cost to the customer. The BLCCDD and SWFWMD will each contribute 50% of the cost of each Showerhead.

Process:

The following procedure will be utilized for the determination of qualification and approval of participation:

1. The applicant will submit an application to BLCCDD.
 - a. The showerheads will not be provided until this document is completely filled out, accurate, and provided to BLCCDD Customer Service.
2. After submitting application, the customer will determine which WaterSense labeled showerhead they would like, the options are listed below:
 - a. WaterSense labeled handheld showerhead.
 - b. WaterSense labeled direct mount showerhead.
3. WaterSense labeled showerheads will be provided to customer.

The Applicant Requirements:

Thank you for your interest in participating in the WaterSense labeled Showerhead Replacement Program. To qualify for the upgrade program, the applicant must meet and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Own a house inside the BLCCDD service area.
2. Currently have an existing shower that is utilizing a high-volume showerhead.
3. A maximum of two (2) showerheads will be provided depending on the number of showers in the home.
4. Funding is limited and only eight hundred (800) WaterSense labeled showerheads are available.
5. The WaterSense Labeled Showerhead Upgrade Program is contingent upon approval of funding from related parties and in the event, funding is not available the program shall be rendered null and void.
6. BLCCDD and the SWFWMD reserve the right to alter this program at any time.
7. Program ends on December 31, 2022.
